




Potentate Trip Recap

From June 12–14, the Potentate and guests embarked on a memorable journey to Louisville, Kentucky, for a unique blend of fellowship, tradition, and exploration of one of America’s most celebrated heritages — bourbon distilling. The trip offered both camaraderie and cultural enrichment, as members enjoyed fine hospitality and the opportunity to learn about Kentucky’s signature spirit.

The adventure began with a visit to the legendary **Stitzel-Weller Distillery**, a historic landmark in bourbon history. Known as the birthplace of iconic brands and the site where bourbon craftsmanship was elevated to an art form, Stitzel-Weller offered a fascinating glimpse into the past. The Potentate and his party explored the storied warehouses, learned about traditional aging techniques, and sampled expressions that embodied generations of skill and passion.

Next, the group traveled to the **Jim Beam Distillery**, one of the most recognizable names in bourbon worldwide. Here, they witnessed the careful balance of tradition and innovation that defines Jim Beam’s legacy. From the scent of mash fermenting in open vats to the warmth of freshly charred oak barrels, the experience was a sensory journey. The guests engaged with master distillers, deepening their appreciation for the meticulous process behind every bottle.

The trip concluded with a stop at **Bulleit Bourbon**, a brand celebrated for its bold, high-rye recipe and distinctive character. The sleek, modern facility contrasted with the rustic charm of earlier visits, highlighting the evolution of bourbon-making in Kentucky. Tasting sessions and discussions about flavor profiles added a refined note to the final day’s activities.

Over the course of three days, the Potentate’s visit to Louisville was more than a tour of distilleries — it was a celebration of heritage, craftsmanship, and shared fellowship. The journey strengthened bonds among those in attendance and deepened their appreciation for the artistry behind one of Kentucky’s proudest traditions.
